## Citation Follow Up

#### Basic In-Text Citation

Sentence with information that you took from a source (Author'sLastName pg#).

Bananas are a great source of energy and proteins. They contain about 100 calories per piece, making it a good source of energy.

(Pederson)

## \*\*Remember that in your bibliography the FIRST word or phrase of the biliography entry goes in the in-text citation!!!

#### Variations on the Rule

- \*If there are no page numbers in your source (webpages, electronic encyclopedias) leave them out
- \*If the source does not have an author: you use whatever the first phrase is in the bibliography--This does not have to be long...just enough to point your reader to the right source citation in your bibliography!
- \*If the source has more than one author: use only the first author's last name and then 'et al.' meaning 'and others'

  (Bissot et al. 4)
